## Timken Family Cancer Center Construction Continues

The Timken Family Cancer Center is beginning to take shape on the east side of Aultman's main campus as we enter into the most exciting phase yet - the actual construction of the new building! The steel has arrived, and cranes began installing beams and columns at the end of June 2021. We've also made tremendous progress on radiation renovations. Our first new linear accelerator, which uses targeted radiation to destroy cancer cells in a precise area, arrived on June 26 and has already been installed, and vault 1 is finished. Once calibration is complete, it will go live this fall. We also have all new waiting room furniture, and we expect the sub waiting and staff lounge to be completed by the end of August. Construction will continue throughout the rest of the year and early into 2022, and we expect the new Timken Family Cancer Center to open in the summer of 2022.
