- **Access Tusc** – \$4,911.25 to support the Pathways Community HUB model for Tuscarawas County. The program builds a network of local social service, education and health care organizations to increase access to local services for underserved and at-risk individuals.
- **AHEAD, Inc.** – \$6,375 to serve middle school students in Massillon City Schools through the Behavior Coach program. Coaches teach at-risk students coping skills and strategies to manage behaviors for success in school, at home and in the community.
- **Alliance Health Family Health Center** – \$5,400 to support its multispecialty primary care and women's health services. The program will reduce barriers with access to care and improve overall health and wellness of patients within elderly and adult populations.
- **Alliance for Children and Families** – \$4,000 to expand health clinic services in a Permanent Supportive Housing location in southwest Canton to improve access to care for low-income families.
- **Beacon Charitable Pharmacy** – \$6,000 to support its charitable pharmacy and ensure the most vulnerable populations have access to vital medications.
- **Beyond the Game** – \$2,500 to support a non-contact football camp for children. The program will help kids of all ages understand that sports can be used as a platform to achieve a higher education, give back to their communities and help reach their potential as adults.
- **Breaking Barriers – Hope is Alive DBA Hope United** – \$5,000 to help individuals fighting addiction stay sober and healthy through counseling and peer support.
- **Children's Dyslexia Center Canton** – \$5,000 to make a difference in the lives of children facing dyslexia through free one-on-one tutoring.
- **Compassion Delivered, Inc.** – \$4,000 to deliver healthy meals to people struggling with chronic, life-threatening diseases and illnesses, at no cost to the clients.
- **Forget-Me-Not Baskets** – \$4,000 to support families grieving pregnancy and infant loss through bereavement bags.
- **GentleBrook** – \$6,000 to give individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities the opportunity to learn and explore the fine arts disciplines.
- **Heritage Christian Schools of Ohio, Inc.** – \$4,250 to educate children on the importance of maintaining a healthy diet, to teach basic cooking skills and to provide a foundation for lifelong healthy eating habits.
- **Pathway Caring for Children** – \$5,000 to assist children with the tools they need to build trusting relationships and to learn appropriate life and social skills through structured activities in the community.
- **Pegasus Farm** – \$4,000 to help eliminate financial barriers for individuals to participate in therapeutic equestrienne services.
- **Pregnancy Care Center of Wayne Co., Inc.** – \$3,750 to support free and confidential reproductive testing and prenatal care services to the community.
- **Pregnancy Support Center of Stark Co. DBA Eva Women's Clinic** – \$3,750 to help offer free and confidential women's health services to uninsured and underinsured women.
- **Refuge of Hope Ministries** – \$4,000 to provide fruits and vegetables in community meals to local men, women and children facing hunger.
- **Stark County Diaper Bank** – \$4,000 to establish a community work/storage space to provide more diapers to families in need through a network of community partners.

- **Stark County Hunger Task Force** – \$3,500 to provide weekend backpacks of food for children struggling with hunger at nine local elementary school sites.
- **VANTAGE Aging** – \$4,000 to support efficient kitchen operations to continue preparing and delivering meals to individuals at home through the Meals on Wheels program.
- **Wayne County Committee for Crippled Children and Adults, Inc.** – \$5,000 to support programming to provide better quality of life for individuals facing impairments, disabilities and developmental delays.
- **Whole Latte Love Café, Inc.** – \$5,000 to provide a vocational training option for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Through a working café environment, individuals learn transferable customer service skills and independent life skills.
