2021 Grant Awards

- **Access Health Stark County** – \$3,000 to support the mobile Community Health Worker program to assist clients with health-related services.
- **Adaptive Sports Ohio** – \$4,000 to support weekly sports programs for individuals with physical and visual disabilities.
- **Alliance Pregnancy Center** – \$3,100 to support the medical clinic and pregnancy resources in Alliance.
- **Big Brothers Big Sisters of Summit, Medina and Stark Counties** – \$3,000 to support the one-on-one mentoring program for youth.
- **Boys & Girls Club of Massillon** – \$2,000 to assist program participants with behavioral and mental health counseling services.
